How should I examine a document?




When examining any document it is important to first assess the security features contained within it.

In **PRADO**, you will find descriptions of the most important security features of documents, like watermarks, security threads, page and photo integration, and so on. These security features can relatively easily be checked, if you know what they should look like, by **"FEEL, LOOK, TILT"**.

- First always check for impersonation. Carefully compare the image to the holder. Also check age, height and signature.
- Special printing makes the ink feel raised or thicker. To feel raised intaglio print, run your finger over it or scratch it gently with your fingernail.
- Watermark and see-through-register: Hold the document against the light.
- Check micro- and miniprint with a magnifying glass.
- Check UV features if you have a UV light available.

What is PRADO?

PRADO is a public multilingual site containing information on security features of authentic identity and travel documents, visas and stamps.

PRADO contains images and summary information on some of the most commonly used documents of the Member States of the European Union and also of some third countries.

Who should use PRADO?

The general public, including governmental and nongovernmental organisations, e.g.:

- Employers
- Postal services
- Banks and credit institutions
- Security companies
- Vehicle hire agencies
- Notaries

Why?

- Undetected identity fraud is dangerous and expensive.
- Legal obligations to check identity will increase.

Key Features

Highest quality and reliability

- FADO (False and Authentic Documents Online) is a classified restricted system for the exchange of information between document experts on travel and identity documents, established pursuant to the Council Joint Action 98/700/JHA. Part of the information on authentic documents contained in FADO is released to the public via the PRADO system. PRADO contains information on selected security features of travel and identity documents. This information is made available on the website of the Council of the European Union.
- PRADO is regularly updated with information taken from the steadily growing FADO database.
- Each document is validated for correctness by document experts all over Europe.
- High quality translations are performed by specialised translators.
- Information on new authentic documents is visible in PRADO the day after they are accepted in FADO. (1)
